This SUN establishes Continued Certification for currently Listed UL 1703 Listing Reports and introduces UL 61730-1 and UL 61730-2 as the superseding Standards.

Superseded Standard: UL 1703 Flat-Plate Photovoltaic Modules and Panels

EFFECTIVE DATE OF NEW/REVISED REQUIREMENTS

Effective Date: December 4, 2019 August 31, 2021 (new or revised products)

IMPACT, OVERVIEW, AND ACTION REQUIRED

Impact Statement: Currently listed products to UL 1703 will be able to remain certified to UL 1703 after the effective date. After the effective date, if a change to the product is made, the product must have a full evaluation to both UL 61730-1 and UL 61730-2.

NOTE: Effective immediately, this new standard will be exclusively used for evaluation of new products unless the Applicant requests <u>in writing</u> that current requirements be used along with their understanding that their listings will need to be evaluated to the superseding standard if a change is made after the effective date.
