This SUN establishes Continued Certification for currently Listed UL 2111 Listing Reports and introduces UL 60730-2-2 as the superseding standard.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF NEW/REVISED REQUIREMENTS

Effective Date: **October 19, 2018**

IMPACT, OVERVIEW, AND ACTION REQUIRED

Impact Statement:

Existing certifications of Thermal Motor Protectors and Protectors for Hermetic and Semi-Hermetic Compressors to UL 2111 will be allowed to continue to be certified after October 19, 2018 and not be withdrawn provided there are no changes to the thermal protectors that require certification decision or until a new/revised requirement in UL60730-2-2 is determined as “Action Required” to require a file review in the future.

After October 19, 2018, changes to a certified thermal protector, originally evaluated in accordance with UL 2111, requiring a certification decision will require that the thermal motor protector is to be evaluated in its/their entirety to the most updated requirements of UL 60730-2-2.

After October 19, 2018, new certifications will be evaluated to the requirements of UL 60730-2-2 in effect.
