	Info	As a result of this change, ferrules, which have been covered as a Recognized Component Wire Connectors that are covered by the Scope of the Standard for Bare and Covered Ferrules, UL 486F / CSA C22.2 No. 291, will be withdrawn. The Standard for Base and Covered Ferrules will be used to evaluate ferrules intended for use with 1/0 – 20 AWG stranded copper conductors. Products presently certified to UL 486A-486B will be required to meet requirements from UL 486F.
