Annex 101.DVA.1.14		The top handle CHAIN SAW shall be supported by a 10 mm diameter rod, positioned as close as possible behind the power switch. The rod shall be firmly attached to the rear handle by clamp or similar means so that the guide bar plane will be vertical. The rod shall be supported on bearings to produce the lowest possible friction to allow CHAIN SAW rotation. See Figure 2 of ISO 8334:2007. For top handle CHAIN SAWS, the angle ß between the centreline of the GUIDE BAR and the horizontal plane as shown in Figure 2 of ISO 8334:2007 shall not exceed ±25°.

K.1	Info	This clause of Part 1 is applicable, except as follows: Addition: This standard applies to chain saws for cutting wood and designed for use by one person. This standard does not cover chain saws designed for use in conjunction with a guide-plate and riving knife or in any other way such as with a support or as a stationary or transportable machine. This standard does not apply to — chain saws for tree service as defined in ISO 11681-2; or — pole-mounted pruners. The chain saws covered by this standard are designed only to be operated with the right hand on the rear handle and the left hand on the front handle.
