#### STANDARD INFORMATION

If your product is certified to UL 962 and is a retail case good or merchandise display, then it needs to be recertified to UL 970.

Current Standard: Household and Commercial Furnishings [UL 962]

Replacement Standard: Retail Fixtures and Merchandise Displays [UL 970:2020 Ed.1+R:21Oct2022]

### **EFFECTIVE DATE OF NEW/REVISED REQUIREMENTS**

Effective Date: July 12, 2024

### IMPACT, OVERVIEW, AND ACTION REQUIRED

**Impact Statement:** UL 970, Retail Fixtures and Merchandise Displays, was recently released and covers non-refrigerated or non-heated commercial displays and other case goods used in retail establishment. All reports currently certified to UL 962 and fall under the scope of UL 970 need to be evaluated and certified to UL 970 prior to the effective date. Due to the changes between standards, a full evaluation to UL 970 is required.

Below is the scope of UL 970 to help determine the products that fall under this standard.

1	Scope
	These requirements cover non-refrigerated or non-heated commercial displays and other case goods used in retail establishment, including bakeries and restaurants. The term display(s) will be used to refer to all of the types of products covered by this standard. The products are used in accordance with the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70. They are intended for dry, damp, or wet locations. These displays include both electrified and non-electrified products and may include, but are not limited to:
1.1	a) Displays  1) Shelving units (Gondolas);  2) Merchandise kiosks (such as the mini-stores in the middle of a mall);  3) Point of Sale (POS);  4) Motorized displays;  5) Hanging displays;  6) Wall systems;  7) Showcases;  8) Display Cases;  9) Product platforms;  10) Temporary Displays  b) Cash stations  1) Cash Wraps;  2) check-out stands (motorized and non-motorized); and  c) Other types of retail fixtures or case good
	1) Retail use disinfecting equipment
1.2	These requirements cover products rated 600 V ac or less, including those powered by primary or secondary batteries
